

## KEY TERMS AND CONDITIONS STATEMENT BY THE WELSH GOVERNMENT

This statement, on behalf of the Welsh Government, is being issued as part of the launch of recruitment for tribunal members for devolved tribunals in Wales

The purpose of this statement is to provide applicants with an indication of what their key terms of appointment are **likely** to be:

- The appointment will be for a period of 5 years, renewable subject to conditions;
- Where a reserve list has been indicated candidates appointed to a reserve list will be held on the reserve list for later appointment should the need arise for a time-limited period of 18 months;
- although there will be no guarantee of a minimum number of sitting days, the post holder will usually be required to make himself or herself available as and when required. This figure may vary in accordance with business needs and will change from time to time further detail can be found in the recruitment documents.
- You will be paid a daily fee for each day worked, information on current fees for individual tribunals are provided in additional recruitment documents.

A full set of terms and conditions will be made available to the post holder upon their appointment, or upon request prior to appointment.
